News from the Polf Shop for 2011: the pro shop Winter Golf Instruction and Ti-G Golf Programs Ti-G Golf Programs are now available for sign up. Only \$100 for four(4) hours of golf instruction - About the price of one round of golf. Ti-G Golf Programs are conducted Saturday or Sunday mornings, one hour per week for four consecutive weeks. This program is not only beneficial to low handicappers. Beginners, you will learn and understand more about the golf swing in 4 short hours than spending years on the range trying to figure things out. Golf swing mechanics as a whole are not simple and learning to swing on the range during season should be limited the fewest aspects only. Treating a complex subject or action as though it were simple, multiplies its complexity because of the difficulty in systematizing missing and unknown factors or elements. Demanding that golf instruction be kept simple does not make it simple - only incomplete and ineffective. Ti-G Golf programs discuss all the complexities of the entire golf swing from set up to finish in simple terms. Some information will answer questions you have immediately. Other information you will want to think about and digest. You won't know what you don't know until you know. This is a winter program only with sessions starting February 12 - mid April. Each week a new four week session starts so if you miss a week or two you will not miss out on any important information this progressive program provides since you may attend a future session in progress. If I am not in the shop when you call, I will call you to confirm. Ti-G Golf Sessions are limited to 10 people per session. All instruction is conducted indoors. The only aspect eliminated of the golf swing for this learning program - the ball. No ball contact is necessary since you are simply learning the motions involved in your swing. It's just like learning the proper steps to a dance.

Indoor Individual Golf Instruction and February SPECIAL GOLF SWING EVALUATION The golf shop now has a net set up for individual indoor golf lessons and evaluations. We have two cameras for dual views and computer software to help evaluate your swing. Discounts are available for multiple lessons.

Special February weekend offering - \$25 for a video swing analysis. You may call the golf shop to set up an "Evaluation" starting weekend afternoons in February. Glenn will take video of your swing and evaluate your mechanics with you using high speed video and on LCD projector to view your swing in full size. It's not fair to get the jump on your playing partners in 2011, is it?
